
Using the VLC Chatbot "OpenAl Help" on the VLC

The "OpenAl Help" block can be found on the right side of the screen and can be accessed from all VLC activities. It can be used in three working modes:

Working Mode 1: The analysis of marked words or text passages

 Action: Mark any word or a text passage and then click on "Explain" or "Translate" with the option to have the result read out



(tick "Read out") and, if you have heard enough, stop reading out via Stop. For "translate", the target language depends on your browser settings.

Working Mode 2: General Question-Answering

 Action: Use the input field of "OpenAl Help" to ask any (even course-unrelated) question. Enter text, e.g. "How many moons does Mars have?" and click on "ask" (optionally, have it read out.)

Working Mode 3: Direct Question Transfer

• Action: This mode is mainly used in the "How to proceed" activities of each section of a course. By clicking the "VLC/OpenAI" symbol to the right of a question in the "Questions" table, the respective question will be forwarded to "OpenAI Help".

The answers provided by "OpenA Help" use the *gpt-4o-mini* model. They can be copied to the clipboard and are limited to 200 tokens, i.e. to approx. 600 to 800 characters.

The "OpenAl Help" option can also be activated via "E" for 'explain' and "T" for 'translate' in the platform header. This shorthand option guarantees mobile device compatibility.
